



Homework Timetable 2017-2018

This document is to be read in conjunction with the Shavington Academy Homework policy, which details further information and outlines roles and responsibilities of all, to ensure that homework develops achievement and attainment for all pupils.

Year 7

In Year 7, pupils should receive 30 minutes of homework per week as outlined below. Teachers will differentiate the level of homework or amount of time set for homework, depending on the ability level of the group. Some subjects may set extended projects, which run over a number of weeks and require a weekly time commitment of 30 minutes. Please ensure pupils indicate how much time they have spent on all written tasks.

Please note that with effect from Monday 4th September, 2017 the following applies:

Week Commencing 04.09.17 the following subject areas will set one piece of homework:

Mathematics, Philosophy and Ethics (formally RE), PHSE, Modern Languages, ICT

Week Commencing 11.09.17 the following subject areas will set one piece of homework:

Science, English, Geography, Art/Technology, Music, History, PE

This pattern will then continue on a fortnightly cycle.

Year 8

In Year 8, pupils should receive 30 minutes of homework per week as outlined below. Teachers will differentiate the level of homework or amount of time set for homework, depending on the ability level of the group. Some subjects may set extended projects, which run over a number of weeks and require a weekly time commitment of 30 minutes. Please ensure pupils indicate how much time they have spent on all written tasks.

Please note that with effect from Monday 4th September, 2017, the following applies:

Week Commencing 04.09.17 the following subject areas will set one piece of homework:

Science, English, Geography, Art/Technology, Music, History, PE

Week Commencing 11.09.17 the following subject areas will set one piece of homework:

Mathematics, Philosophy and Ethics (formally RE), PHSE, Modern Languages, ICT

This pattern will then continue on a fortnightly cycle.

Year 9, Year 10 and Year 11

In Year 9, Year 10 and Year 11, homework should increase to approximately 60 minutes per subject per week. Subjects will have homework set as appropriate in response to the stages of the Scheme of Work. Some subjects may set extended projects, which run over a number of weeks and require a weekly time commitment of 60 minutes.
