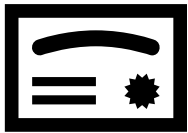
What is an Apprenticeship?

An Apprenticeship is a structured training programme that combines employment with a college course.

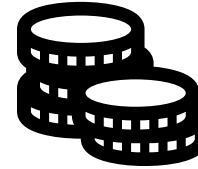
You will:

- Be able to go onto a Degree Apprenticeship

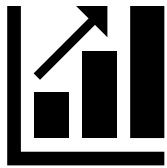

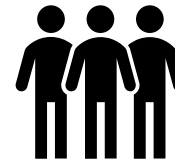

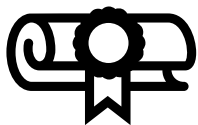

T Levels

T levels are new Level 3 courses that are designed to provide you with the knowledge and experience needed to open doors to skilled employment, further study or a Higher Apprenticeship.

The course provides a mixture of direct teaching (80% of the course) and a longer work experience element of 45 days (20% of the course).

From September 2022, we will be offering the following T Level courses:
