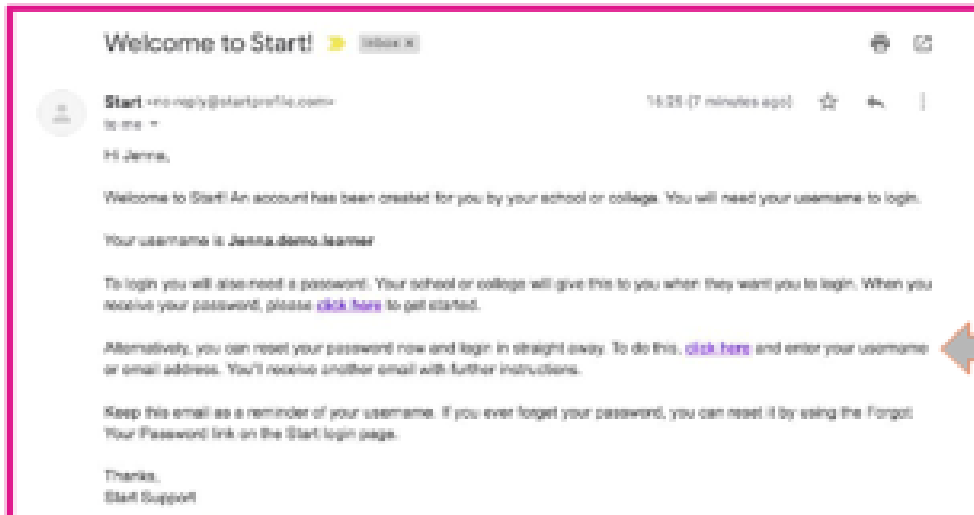
Follow these three simple steps to get started.

If you have received an email like the one below, you can log in straight away by resetting your password by following the link in the email. **TIP** - It might be a good idea to make your password the same as your

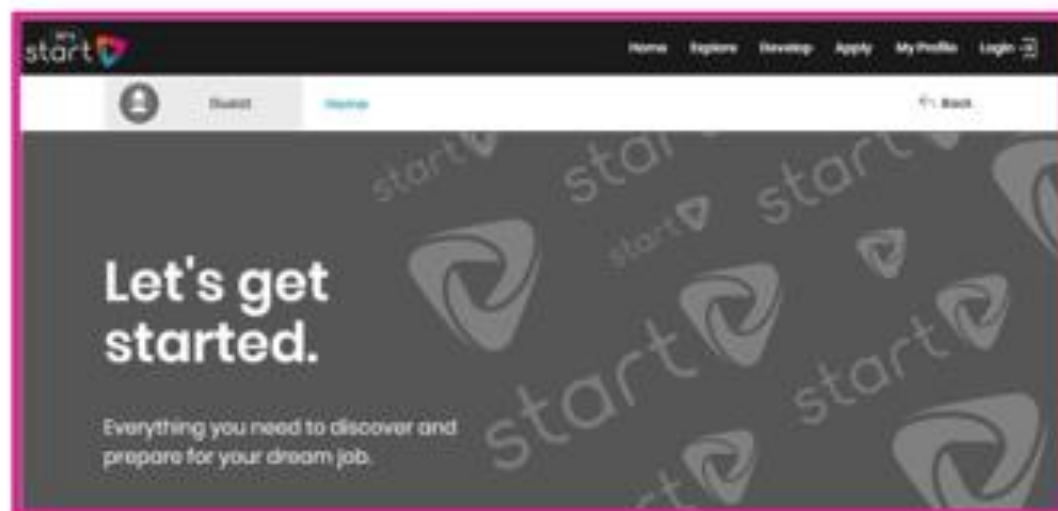

You will arrive at this homepage. Click **'Login'** in the top right corner of the screen.






