

## Revision Resources

Websites frequently recommended by Mathematics Staff to support pupil revision:

1. Corbett Maths (<https://corbettmaths.com>)

On Corbett Maths all resources and content are free. The website has resources tailored for learners of all ages which can be accessed by the tabs at the top of the page.

**Worksheets and Videos** are available on this tab and solutions can also be found. You can search for specific topics within the webpage and there are practice questions as well as textbook exercises.

**5 a day** is a great fast revision resource; these are sheets with 5 topics per day (maximum 8 questions) for every day of the year ordered by date. There are 5 levels of sheet; numeracy, foundation, foundation plus, higher, higher plus. Again, all solutions are available.

**More**, is a tab where practice papers are available for GCSE learners. The model solutions are also available to support pupils checking their answers.

2. Maths Genie (<https://www.mathsgenie.co.uk>)

On maths genie all resources and content are free. The website has resources tailored for learners at GCSE level and above.

**GCSE Revision** is a tab where you can access videos, worksheets and solutions all sorted by GCSE grade. This will support pupils working on topics applicable to their targeted level.

**GCSE Papers** is a tab where pupils can access previous exam papers written by AQA (other exam boards are available but we follow AQA). Solutions are also available.

3. Hegarty Maths (<https://hegartymaths.com>)

At Shavington Academy we subscribe to Hegarty Maths. All pupils can log in using their name and date of birth and the password they set themselves. Hegarty maths has support videos and practice questions online for all users. Pupils can search for their topic of choice at the top of the page once logged in.
