Dear Parents and Carers

I hope that you are well and your son/daughter is enjoying their summer so far. I am writing to provide some more details of the grading processes that have taken place and will take place for your child. All pupil's grades have been closely moderated within the school and externally to ensure that the final grades attributed to each pupil for each of their subjects is the most accurate one given all of the evidence gathered over time.

Teachers and leaders have used all the evidence available and investigated all circumstances to make sure the grading process has been as fair and inclusive as possible. These Teacher Assessed Grades were submitted to the Examination Boards ahead of the 18th June deadline.

The awarding bodies have also been provided with a specific sample of evidence from English Language, Chemistry and Further Mathematics, as they requested on 22nd June. They will now moderate this sample as part of their ongoing Quality Assurance measures and will confirm the final grades that they are awarding to the Academy shortly before the results day itself.

All Year 11 pupils will be able to collect their results from the Academy between 10.00am and 11.30am on Thursday 12th August. Pupils should arrive at Visitor Reception and will be directed from there. Any pupils who are unable to come along to collect results should e-mail exams@shavington.academy providing alternative details and we can arrange for the results to be issued via e-mail later that day. Once pupils have received their results on 12th August, they will have the opportunity to ask for a Centre review if they feel that a particular grade they have been given is wrong.
