Behaviour for Learning Policy Addendum – Covid-19

September, 2020

Whilst we are facing the Covid-19 pandemic, it is essential that we make it clear in our Academy Behaviour for Learning Policy, the specific negative behaviours which will be taken very seriously if a pupil, or a group of pupils do not follow the clear rules, guidance and expectations that have been set out to both them and their parents/carers in writing and verbally.

In arriving at this addendum, we have used Government guidance.

If a pupil exhibits any type of the negative behaviours listed below, then normal school sanctions will be put into place, and in certain circumstances, could lead to a pupil being permanently excluded. Whilst we do not want to take this action, we have to be mindful of keeping everyone in our school community safe.

- Spitting either on the ground or at another person
- Coughing intentionally both in isolation and intentionally around other people
- Intentionally touching another person with the sole purpose of putting that person at risk
- Not socially distancing in school or at the school gates, after being reminded
- Sharing food and drink bottles
- Not bringing in the right equipment
- Wandering around the classroom when it is very clear that they should not be
- Refusal to comply with 'bubbles', zones and entry/exit points
- Not following good hand hygiene
- Not following the 'Catch It, Bin It, Kill It' guidance
- Not using equipment safely or sensibly or as per the chances that practical subjects have put into place to keep everyone safe
- Not disposing of PPE correctly e.g. face masks
- Not wearing a face mask on school transport, not socially distancing where it is possible, such as the bus stop, when in school uniform
- Pupils must not misuse hand sanitiser and any PPE equipment used
- Pupils must not use unallocated zones or mix with pupils from other year groups

The list above is by no means exhaustive and will be reviewed as we return to school and ascertain the negative behaviours that might be being exhibited.
