



### Rationale

### Purpose

To set high standards and values in the school and foster the sense of school ethos and culture.

### What is acceptable?

Blazer	Plain Black
Shirt	White
Skirt	Black Knee Length tailored fit ( <u>not stretch</u> ) <b>We do not have a Shavington school skirt</b>
Tights	Black <b>or</b> flesh coloured, <u>NO</u> over the knee socks
Trousers	Black tailored school trousers - <u>NOT 'skinny' fit or fashion style</u> . Legging style trousers are also not permitted.
Jumper	Plain black V neck jumper (optional) - no logos or branding. Round neck jumpers are not permitted.
School Tie	Clip-on tie in house colour - available from school
School Badge	Available from school
Shoes	Plain black shoes in a sensible style with no logos and the material should be waterproof. No trainers/trainer style shoes/boots.
Outdoor Coat	Hooded tops or tops with logos are not acceptable. Please do not bring expensive coats into school.

### P.E Kit

Plain white polo shirt

Black school shorts

### What is not acceptable?

Hooded sweatshirts, t-shirts, tracksuit tops. These are not permitted inside the building. Inappropriate tops / hoodies may be confiscated from pupils

Jeans/jeans cut, cords, canvas trousers, skinny fit, trousers with splits. Fashion belts.

Canvas shoes, trainers, sports branded 'logoed' shoes or boots, as well as trainer style shoes

Multiple earrings (only 2 studs per ear / any other facial piercings must not be worn. **Facial piercings, flesh tunnels and large stretcher earrings are not allowed in school.** If they cannot be removed they need to be covered with a plaster or a clear retainer

Rings / bracelets / fashion bands / necklaces

Excessive make-up. Nail polish, false nails, nail extensions as well eye lash extensions are not permitted

Skirts worn with leggings

Extreme hairstyles, including multi-coloured hair. Hair must be of natural colour

Large decorative, hair accessories

Visible body art

Beaded hair is not appropriate for school unless worn for cultural reasons. Head coverings for religious purposes may be worn to school, but may not obscure the face

Please ensure that all items of uniform and kit are clearly marked with names. Pupils not in correct uniform will be dealt with by their Form Tutor or Deputy Pastoral Leader/Pastoral Leader which may result in:

- Corrective uniform provided
- Phone call to parents/carers to rectify situation
- Removal from school community to work in internal seclusion
